

2011 Molo Quint LLC Scholarship Program

Eligibility:

Applicants must be full-time (30 hours or more) employees of Molo Quint LLC or be children or the spouse of an active full-time (30 hours or more) Molo Quint LLC employee. The employee must have a **minimum of ONE year** of employment experience with Molo Quint LLC, as of July 15, 2011.

Applicants must be either high school seniors, high school graduates or college undergraduates enrolled in or planning to enroll in full-time course of study at a recognized and accredited institution.

Scholarship Awards:

Scholarships will be awarded as follows:

Annual awards for four-year accredited college or university will be given in three levels: Bronze - \$500.00; Silver - \$1,000.00; and, Gold - \$1,500.00.

Annual awards for two-year, vocational/technical college and community college programs will be given in three levels:

Bronze - \$500.00; Silver - \$750.00; and, Gold - \$1,000.00.

Funds will be distributed via check made payable to the institution and the student.

Application:

Students must complete the application and mail it along with other required information (attached) to Molo Quint LLC Scholarship Committee (address attached) by May 6, 2011. Applicants are solely responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. All information submitted is confidential and will be reviewed only by the Scholarship Committee. Recipient Selection:

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic achievement, leadership and participation in school and community activities, work experience, statement of educational and career goals, contents of application and recommendation by an adult. First time applicants will be given preferential consideration. Depending on the number of applicants, all applicants may not receive awards.

Scholarship Decisions will be announced by telephone or email by the Scholarship Committee by May 31, 2011.

Obligations:

Scholarship recipients must enroll in their educational programs no later than fall of the year in which their awards are given. Recipients are required to provide Molo Quint LLC Scholarship Committee with any change of address, school enrollment or other pertinent information.

Revision Policy:

The general conditions and procedures under which scholarships are made are subject to periodic review by Molo Quint LLC, including termination of the program.
